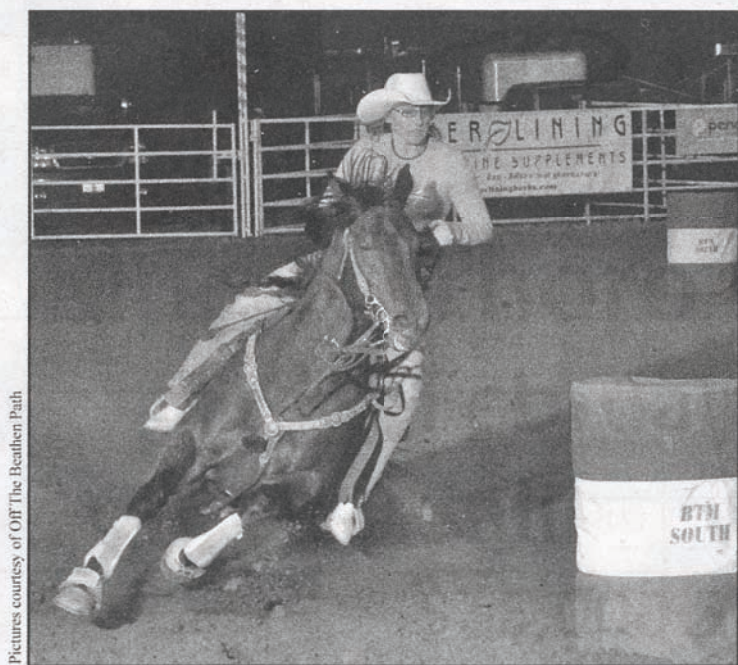

Scott Wins the Exacta at C-T February Race

Scott hits the exacta winning on all three of her mounted entries including the open average title at C-T Productions Barrel Race February 19-21. The competition was fierce right up to the end as nobody knew who would win the average. C-T Productions added \$1000 each day and \$2,000 in average awards. The race was also co-sanctioned with the WPRA, ACBRA and PAC WEST. The thrilling barrel race paid over \$18,500 with 400 overall competitive entries for the challenging weekend. C-T also hosted the NBHA Distist 15 barrel race on Saturday starting at 2PM. The astonishing Bailey Tuck riding "In the Sky Bar" ran a smokin' time of 14.937 running 3/10th faster than any of her fellow rival competitors. This is the second time Tuck has had the fastest time, what a stunning run! On Saturday alone, C-T Productions ran over 200 contestants between the NBHA race and C Bar T races combined. In conjunction with their November race C-T will host the WPRA Co-sanction/Permit finals, and the CA. Jr. WPRA finals.

What a bet as Jandee Scott from Red Bluff placed in the average with a Win, Place and Show making nine spotless runs. Riding her open average horse "BCR Stella Bella" aka Stella and taking home some very nice awards including ... the 1D Champion Buckle. Scott showed great communication with all her horses when she sprinted her way to place 5th in the 1D Average on her second horse, "Colonels April Smoke" and then Scott placed second in the 2D Average riding "Tuff N Cash." What a remarkable individual and to reward her efforts she took home \$1,213.94 in winnings. Scott's long necked, long stride bay mare Stella was bought as a four year old off the track after

she won her last race. "BCR Stella Bella" is by "For Really" a Thoroughbred standing at Victory Rose Thoroughbreds, Vacaville with a performance race record of 37-7-8-6, winning \$481,681. On the bottom Stella is by "Dash Te Fame" out of "First Down Dash," SI-105 AAAT ROM Race(SW) \$857,256 ALL TIME LEADING RACE SIRE, need I say more. "I am excited because I have never won anything at Tulare before," said Scott. "Stella is now 7 years old and I love her, she is coming along pretty fast. I have always liked the payouts here at Tulare and Erik is up at six in the morning working the ground. I should know, I was parked next to the arena and could hear the tractor's start up. I am looking forward to coming to the finals this year," said Scott. Stella was trained by her mother Mary.

Winning the 2D Average was Julie Adams winning two checks for a total of \$465.18, riding her grulla colored gelding "Jesse Leo Jr." aka "Mouse." Adams hails from Madera, CA. and was sick with the flu all weekend and said that "Mouse hasn't run much in two years, he fat and out of shape, but I was real happy with his runs. I just held on, Mouse is broke. Mouse is an own son of two time world champion cutter Jesse Leo Jr. and by Impressive on the bottom." Adams remarked that "Mouse used to be my all-around horse and won the AQHA Silver Dollar Circuit Futurity All-Around, he heads, heels, calf-ropes and has his ROM in halter. Mouse is such a great horse, he is twelve years old and runs and plays in the back yard with the kids and steals their candy." Adams mother hand raised and bottle fed Mouse as a colt, when it's mother wouldn't nurse.

Bakersfield is the hometown to the 3D Average Champion Vicki Jensen riding her horse "Summers Smokey Rose" aka Rose who is by "Cow Bar" on the top and by "Doc O'Lena" on the bottom. Jensen has owned her horse for a year and a half and trained her horse to run barrels after her mare was retired from the cutting pen. "Her first year out she won a saddle here. I love the ground here, you feel very safe here on all your runs. Erik does a great job on the dirt," said Jensen. Her eleven year old black mare "Rose" ran her best time on Saturday with a 16.673.

Shelly Pelowski won the 4D Average Champion buckle riding her buckskin gelding Skip King Chex aka "KC" Pelowski's 9 year old mount placed her in two go rounds and she pocketed \$451.44 for the weekend. Shelly has been riding KC for four years and said that "she was very excited. It's cool and I enjoy riding KC! He won two checks this weekend". Besides barrels Pelowski likes to use her horse on trail rides and working cattle. "KC used to be in the Riverside County Sheriffs Possie," said Pelowski.

The fastest thing around this weekend was Baily Tuck again, running the best time all weekend of 14.937. Bailey had a successful weekend riding her sorrel gelding "In the Sky Bar" aka "Spy" for a weekend total payout of \$610.99. Friday's fastest time was run by Katie McCaslan riding her palamino stud "Chopper" stopping the clock at 15.112 winning \$456.94 in that go-round and a total of \$965.91 after two go's. Sunday's fastest time went to Jandee Scott with a 15.249 winning \$420.08 in that go-round and \$1,213.94 total for the weekend.

The Futurity winner was Katie Phillips who bested the field riding her "Otro Sonador" with a very respectful time of 15.607 and won \$144.63 in the futurity which had \$100 added. The 2D Futurity was won by the attractive Emily Dunn 16.995 \$77.87 riding

her homegrown 4 year old 15.3 hand futurity prospect "Rich." Dunn raised the colt from her mare "Pitch" who is by "Other Brother Daryell" who goes back to "Skipper W" and "Peter McCue" and bred to the stallion "Living Richly." Dunn also placed on him in the NBHA race held earlier that day. "Jeri Mann and her mother Nina Dunn should get the credit for training her young prospect. He is fun and honest" said Dunn of her big sorrel colt. She also mentioned that "I like the added money at these races and they are very thoughtful, great people." Nice comments coming from a very talented, selfless young horsewoman.
